

# Privacy Notice



At Mark Masons' Hall we respect the privacy rights of our online visitors and recognise the importance of protecting the information we collect about you. Our Privacy Policy is designed to help you understand how we collect, hold, use and disclose personally identifiable information about you.

For the purpose of the European General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR") and UK Data Protection Act 2018 we are the data controller.

## Your information
