The Grand Master's Lodges of Instruction meet on First and Third Monday of each month, commencing with the Masonic season starting in September to March at **Mark Masons' Hall, 86 St. James's Street, London SW1A 1PL.**



What we do

The Advancement and Elevation ceremonies are rehearsed at each meeting; with the Elevation ceremony starting at 5.00pm and the Advancement ceremony starting at 6pm. The Installation ceremonies for Mark and R.A.M. are rehearsed once each month on alternate Mondays; and also when requested by the members to accommodate their individual schedule.

The Lodges of Instructions' season culminates with the Annual Festival, at which the Advancement and Elevation ceremonies are demonstrated, and is usually held during the last week in April, on a date and at a venue, mutually agreed by the GMLol's committee and also the committee of the host Mark Province.

Dress Code

The instructions are given in a friendly and relaxed manner to an approved standard of ritual, to fit individual requirement and need. Regalia is not worn for the GMLol, but smart casual dress is a requirement at M.M.H. (no jeans or trainers!).
